Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs Announcement - Tonika Lockhart-Mackie, VCAA Senator

- Request from LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans to Approve the Reorganization of the Basic Sciences Departments in the School of Medicine
  - o Board of Supervisors (BoS) approved October 24, 2025
  - Next step: Board of Regents (BoR) approval -hopefully on their December 10, 2025 agenda.
- Request from LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans to Convert the Doctor of Nursing Science Degrees Awarded between 1988 and 2021 to the Doctor of Philosophy in Nursing Degree
  - o BoS approved on October 24, 2025
- Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) changes: New president. Principles of accreditation will be revised over the next 2 years. QEP may become optional.
- Office of Research Services (ORS) Executive Director: Joseph Constans has been hired. His full-time start date is January 12, 2026. He begins working part-time Nov 21,2025.
- Dental school regarding Notification of Change: Internationally Educated Dentists Program 2025-2026: Letter sent to LSU Baton Rouge to be submitted to Board of Regents.

• Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Data Change: The Dept of Education has changed the requirements for reporting admissions information for the upcoming Winter Survey. Whereas LSUHSC used to be exempt from the admissions survey as we do not admit First-Time Freshman, the Dept of Ed is now requiring admissions data on transfers-in. For now, this requirement is only for undergraduate programs. We are therefore now required to report disaggregated data on race, gender, admit rates, and other metrics for matriculants and applicants to all our undergraduate programs.

- 1. Feedback: Similar to IT Office Hours, can it be set up where when the meeting notice is sent, we can add it to our Outlook calendars?
- Response: Yes, it now exists on the website-meetings schedule
- 2. Feedback: I think something that would be very helpful for staff is an explanation at the beginning of each general assembly meeting on what the purpose of the staff senate it. I am still unclear what that is and I attend most meetings. I would like to see the staff senate be a united team that has actionable plans to advocate and retain staff.
- 2a. Feedback: It is unclear what the staff senate's purpose and responsibly is. Is this a group that functions as a liaison between institution leadership and administrators? Is this a group that plans pumpkin carving events? Is this a group to help promote and advocate for staff? I would like to see the staff senate elevate the staff into leadership conversations and be taken seriously by institutional leaders.

- 7. Feedback: Can the staff senate consider gathering and publishing more information on candidates for the next staff senate election. I think it would be easy and important to have their department, position, years of service, and reason for wanting to sit on the staff senate. This can be collected when nominations are accepted. I think it would give the staff a chance to select a diverse group and not just vote based off of name recognition.

- 8. Would it be possible for LSUHSC to do salary adjustment not a raise for staff that have been here over 25 years? What is the process of obtaining a salary adjustment?
